Dates:

- Registration and postal submission to the competition is open until 16th August 2024.
- The winners will be announced on 6th September 2024.
- The artworks will be exhibited in different venues from 6th September to 6th December 2024.

Works:

The competition is open to all printing disciplines and printed digital works.

- Each artist may submit up to 3 different works.
- There is no minimum image size but all works must only be produced on paper 20 x 20 cm.
- Submissions must date from 2022 onwards and be the work of a living artist.
- All submitted artwork will be signed on the front. The technical specifications and artist's information should be written legibly on the back.

The works should be marked as **"FOR EXHIBITION ONLY"** and sent by REGISTERED MAIL in a simple packet, unframed, without glass or mount and bearing the declaration **"NO COMMERCIAL VALUE"** by the 16th August 2024. The postal stamp must confirm that deadline.

II Mini Print Internacional Galicia

The Asociación Taller Experimental de Obra Múltiple Contemporánea (ATEOMC) of Vilariño, Cangas do Morrazo, the Dirección Xeral de Cultura de the Xunta de Galicia, the Provincial Government of Pontevedra, the Cangas Town Council, the Faculty of Fine Arts of the University of Vigo, and private entities are collaborating, for the first time, in organising this international printmaking competition, which, as in the previous edition, is being held at the “Ángel Botello” Exhibition Hall in the Casa de la Cultura of Cangas.

The institutional synergies created around our competition were reflected in a 35% increase in participation from artists hailing from Argentina, Australia, Austria, Belarus, Belgium, Brazil, Bulgaria, Canada, Chile, Denmark, Slovakia, Spain, France, Greece, Hungary, India, Italy, Mexico, Norway, the Netherlands, Poland, Portugal, the United Kingdom, South Korea, Sweden, Taiwan, Ukraine, Uruguay, and Japan. A total of 124 artists are presenting 322 works, of notable quality and diverse concepts and techniques, signifying the consolidation of our competition within the competitive international artistic scene of printmaking.

My congratulations to the artists María Luisa Pascual Langle, María Deak Nemeth, and Mercè Grifé Canals, who were awarded the three cash prizes, and to Lola Abad García and Agata Perzynska, who received Honourable Mentions. Congratulations also to Weronika Siupka, winner of the Mini Print Galicia 2023, whose exhibition titled “Auto de fé” further elevated the significance of the collective show.

From ATEOMC, we would like to thank the collaboration of the members of our association and workshop, the staff of the Casa de la Cultura de Cangas, the members of the international jury, and the companies and professionals who facilitated and contributed throughout the entire process of executing the Mini Print Internacional Galicia 2024, leading to the successful results mentioned above.

Jury Minutes

As President of the prestigious jury, comprised of Weronika Siupka from Poland, Néstor Goyanes from Argentina, and Xoán Pastor, Maite Meixide, and Fruela Alonso Blanco from Galicia (Spain) – artists and cultural managers with prominent national and international careers – I would like to express my satisfaction with the significant participation and the remarkable quality of the numerous works received from Argentina, Australia, Austria, Belgium, Belarus, Brazil, Bulgaria, Canada, Denmark, France, Greece, Hungary, India, Italy, Japan, Korea South, Mexico, Netherlands, Poland, Portugal, Slovakia, Spain, United Kingdom, Sweden, Taiwan, Ukraine and Uruguay.

The jury's decision was approved unanimously and the winning works were the following:

First prize for María Luisa Pascual Langle, with the work *Sin título II*, from Spain, with a financial prize of 2000 euros;

Second prize for María Deak Nemeth, with the work *Revelation III*, from Hungary, with a financial prize of 1000 euros;

Third prize for Mercè Grifé Canals with the work *Natura avis II*, from Spain, with a financial prize of 500 euros.

Honorable mentions: Lola Abad García, author of the work *Ponts*, from Spain and Agata Perzynska, author of the work *Blank facies IV*, from Poland.
